1st floor - ground level contains

Parking / trash facility

If entering the property from the lower parking lot on Grandview Drive, you'll find plenty of parking spaces, along with the dumpster enclosure.

2nd floor - main level contains

Foyer / kitchen

When entering the condo, you'll first walk into a hallway style foyer and kitchen area with copper countertops, large farmhouse style sink, refrigerator, oven, 4-eye electric stovetop, microwave, toaster, coffee maker, blender, and crockpot. With a full pantry, the space was renovated for maximum storage.

First bedroom / first bathroom

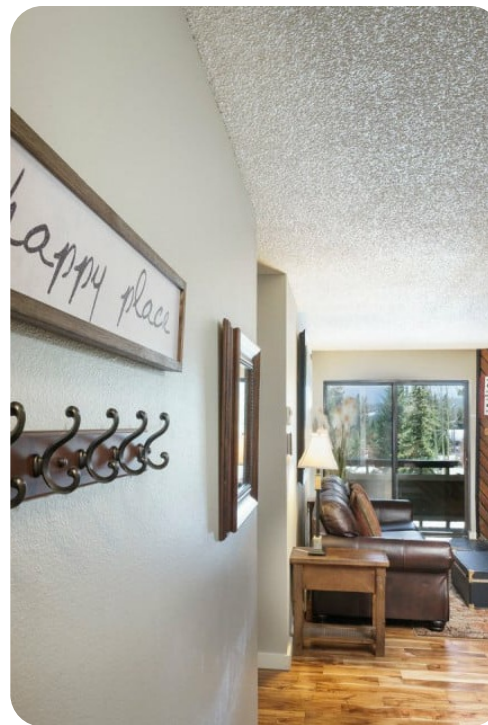
